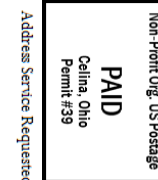

There is a suddenly ready to come. There will be an epicenter that's related around what you guys are doing. You've been sowing and sowing and sowing. Get this seed in the ground. But there comes a suddenly, and when that suddenly happens, you'll have to step in to it and not run through it, learn to linger in that moment because when the scripture says wait to braid together, weave together like a cord. At that moment is when the braiding and weaving and strengthening is happening, and that's what's going to really

empower you to what's to come. Don't miss that moment. Get enthralled with worship. He inhabits, hangs out, lives there, pitches his tent there, in the high praises of God, it means the throne room access. Let the high praises of God, the praises that acknowledges who He is, that's acknowledgement as in terms of judgements and justice and who He is — let the high praise of God be in
