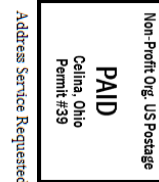

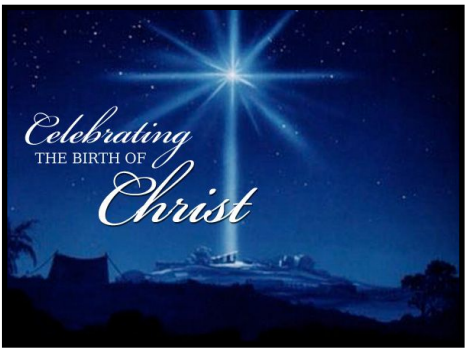

CALL MINISTRIES

C.A.L.L. stands for Community Action Life Line. This non-profit, Christian based organization is so much more than a food pantry! Not only do they collect and distribute food items to the needy, they also grow their own food year round, provide beds and clothing, and have an established backpack program that our church is involved with. Every Tuesday, C.A.L.L CAFE serves a free hot meal at the fairgrounds to the hungry. It is so important to not only just feed people physically for a day, but to also feed them spiritually. They serve over 750 local families which is over 2,000 individuals per month! All of this is happening without government grants so that they can minister in the name of Jesus.

Since they do not generate income through any type of sales, they must rely on the support from the local community. Though costs continue to rise, financial support has actually lowered in the past 3 years. As you consider your financial budget for 2020, prayerfully think about if you can help the LOCAL ministry right here in your backyard. Your dollar will be stretched to the fullest as they have a totally unpaid volunteer staff. Another great opportunity CALL provides is their Work4Program where clients "work for" a vehicle by volunteering hours at the facility. If you happen to have a road worthy vehicle to donate, this would be totally tax deductible. I am sure that your donation of any kind would be appreciated and used wisely for our fellow brothers and sisters in need.
