

2020 FINANCIAL OUTLOOK

Last Wednesday night I covered the 2019 Year-end Financial Report for the church. Every year we do this in compliance with the IRS standards. We always use this time to remind members of the financial structure that we have in place for New Life in the areas of Tithes, Offerings, and Alms according to the biblical precedent set forth in God's Word.

The beginning of 2019 was exciting as we finished the Phase 2 construction of more classroom space, a kitchen, new interior HVAC units, and the doubling of the size of the restrooms. We were able to do this WITHOUT adding any debt to the church due to the generous giving we experienced in May of 2018! Additionally, we were able to add yet another row of parking in the lot, install a drainage tile from the parking lot to the creek, and level the ground in the north end of our property, add several trees to the property, as well as several other smaller items that needed updated or repaired.

As it stands now we only owe one investor back for the money we borrowed for the Phase 1 building project we undertook a few years ago. We continue to put \$2,500 per month in escrow to repay this final debt. At this pace we should be completely DEBT FREE by the Fall of this year! Praise God!

Looking ahead, once we are debt free we will continue to explore ideas we have had to further improve our property for even greater use of what we have. That will eventually include the construction of a nice shelter house to host outdoor cookouts, youth events, team events, etc. We have already received money to start an account specifically for this future request.

Lastly, we want to remind you that although we put much money into the property (necessarily) over the past couple years, our first priority is still to invest in ministry more than anything else!
