

HEAR AND DO WHAT I SAY

Isaiah 50:4

What does it take to be in the family of God? In Luke 8:21, Jesus tells us who His real family is! Those who hear and do the Word of God. Jesus has an expectation of each of us that not only do we hear, but we also act on what we hear the Father speak to us. In Luke 6:46, just prior to this conversation of who His real family is, "Jesus

responds to them, " Why do you call He awakens Me, Lord, Lord and my ear to listen do not do what I as a disciple. say?" What is the point Jesus is trying The Lord has to get across? It's opened my ear. not good enough to just hear a good message or talk a good game. We

have to put action to what we believe. We call that faith! Imagine if you will for a moment, that you are in a parent and child relationship. As the parent, you tell the child to clean their room prior to going outside to play with friends. The child hears what you say to them, but promptly heads outside to play instead. As the parent, how would you feel? You would be upset, you would call your child in and ask them why they didn't do what

you asked? After all their excuses, you would then discipline them and make sure they do what they were told to do. After about 30 minutes you go check on them and they have decided to play video games in their room instead of cleaning up. How would you feel? Probably pretty angry!

> Now, apply this to our relationship with

> > our Heavenly Father. How many times does He ask us to do something and we willingly do something other than what He asked us to do? Jesus explains to us in the parable

of the sower, that people keep on hearing, but don't understand. They keep on seeing, but don't perceive. That's not the group of people we want to be. We want to have the testimony of Jesus who said, "I do only what the Father tells me to do." John 5:30. In Isaiah 50:4, He awakens My ear to listen as a disciple. The Lord has opened my ear." As a born one of God, we should be able to hear His voice clearly! - John 10:27
