

For the last month or so, the Lord has been speaking to us as a church family about overcoming. I would like to share another aspect to overcoming through the lens of "who I am in Christ". Looking at the life of Jesus, we find that Jesus knew who He was at an early age. Luke 2:49 Jesus tells us that He was about His Father's business. Jesus knew exactly who He was

exactly who He was b a s e d o n t h e relationship He had with His heavenly Father. In several places throughout Scripture, we see Jesus stating that He knew His purpose.

1 John 3:8 tells us for this purpose Jesus

was made manifest, to destroy the works of the devil. In John 18:37, Jesus goes on to give great clarity on why He was born. That He might reintroduce the Kingdom of God into this world. To testify that He is the King of kings and Lord of lords. My point is this, Jesus was able to live His life effectively based on that fact that He knew who He was. There was no confusion on what He was to be doing or where He should be going. How was Jesus able to fight off temptation? Because He knew what He was called to do. He was offered a

counterfeit authority by the devil, yet He was able to resist. I believe a big reason why christians are not overcoming is because they don't realize who they are in Christ. In Galatians 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ; It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave Himself

for me." We have a new identity! Our old self has been crucified. My new self, is Christ! This means that where I go, Christ goes, when I speak, Christ is speaking. Notice that He "gave" Himself for

us. We don't have to earn or achieve a new identity. He grants it to us! That's good news! Our world is filled with, "achieve this," "work for that," "do this and get that." Jesus, on the other hand says, if you believe in Me, I will grant you a new name, a new identity. Now, just like Jesus, when any type of trial comes our way, we can overcome because of who now lives in us! Romans 8:11 tells us the same spirit dwells in us that dwelt in Jesus. That means we overwhelmingly conquer based on His life flowing through us!
