Ruth 1:16 The story of Ruth is a fascinating tale of a woman who goes from a seemingly hopeless situation to then being

grafted into the lineage of Jesus Christ. Not to mention, that her great grandson became one of the greatest Kings in all of the history of Israel. Is all of this because of her great family history? Or maybe the wealth

she accumulated over the years? Or how about her intellect? No, by the world's standards, she was an outcast. No hope, no future. In the midst of all the turmoil in her life, the death of her husband, no children, no home, she decides to do the unthinkable. She tells her mother-in-law that she will serve her until the day she dies. Where you go, I will go
