PRIESTS UNTO GOD

"You are My Son, today I have begotten You. You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek." Hebrews 5:5-6. What is the author of Hebrews trying to communicate to us in regards to the priesthood of Melchizedek? At the root of this new priesthood, sonship is its basis. Jesus, the first born, has demonstrated what it is like to be a priest in this new order. We as His brethren, born ones, are to follow the example that Jesus has set. We are pure, because He first was pure. We are righteous, because He first was righteous. One of the main purposes of Jesus coming to earth was to be able to have a priesthood of sons and daughters. Hebrews 2 states "that it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, that bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings."
