


DSM classes start September 13, for students and it is not too late to register! Full-time or parttime is available and we encourage people of all ages to consider learning with us!

The Fruit

reveals

the Root

Proverbs 18:21 death and life are in the power of the tongue and those who love it will eat its fruit (will reap the consequences - NLT). We all know the biblical expression "you reap what you sow," but this Scripture clearly states that we will reap even from the fruit of our lips. If we ever sow lies, deceit, or gossip, we must

understand the consequences will come back upon us. In 1 Kings 22, we see that a lying spirit actually volunteered to deceive King Ahab into going to battle where he met his ultimate

demise. It was a SPIRIT! When we bear false witness in any way whatsoever we are entertaining and animating a spirit that wants to express its nature through us. In other words, we are representing the seed of the great liar the devil himself. John 8 says, "you are of your father the devil... Who is the father of lies." The condition of our fleshly, outward man is corrupt beyond repair! That is why God had to place

a new (kainos) seed within us which is incorruptible. In fact it was for this reason that Jesus the son of God was manifested, to destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8).

Remember that the **Fruit** reveals the Root. In other words if you examine the fruit of your lips you can tell from which root it came. If

you spew bitterness from your mouth, the root (source) is a Root of Bitterness. Another way to say it is that "Root dictates Fruit." The root or vine can only

produce of its own kind. Apples cannot grow on an orange tree. Likewise, good fruit of the Spirit cannot grow on the tree/ root of lies, bitterness, etc. The good news is that the opposite is also true: bad, corrupt fruit CANNOT grow on the tree/root of the Spirit! Therefore we have our solution: walk in the Spirit and you will NOT fulfill the lusts of the flesh!
