BROKEN

Have you ever noticed when reading about the miracles recorded in scripture, those who receive the miracles are, how do we say it, "with their back against a wall", "between a rock and a hard place" or "at the end of their rope", or "completely broken"? However we describe it we see that because of the circumstances of their situation, they realize they are unable to contribute anything

We see this to save

scripture, from those who were wronged by someone, by those in need of healing in their body, or by those who were without food. You insert your favorite example. One example of the opposite comes to mind. When the rich young ruler came to Jesus, the Bible reveals that he knew he was lacking something. When Jesus instructed him in how to obtain what was lacking, he went away sorrowful. I would say he was not at the end of himself. He still maintained the hope that he could obtain what was lacking from the things he had acquired. I believe

he was seeking justification. We can only be justified by Jesus! The deception is that things can justify us and the reality is that things can own us.

The Word instructs us to put off the old and put on the new. As we do, empowered by grace, we are kept from the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eye, and the pride of life.

As much as we want to

avoid that broken condition, we would be blessed to realize that we are mere vessels given the ability, by our Creator, to choose this day who we will serve. It is true 'we are <u>more than</u> <u>conquerors</u> through Him who loved us'. It

is also true, 'The LORD is near to those who have a <u>broken heart</u>, and saves such as <u>have a contrite</u> spirit'.

As a fellowship we have been exhorted, for our equipping, to make an effort, to go beyond our norm, to set aside our comfort zones, to make a noise, to consecrate ourselves, cultivating Godly sorrow and seeking Him with our whole heart, pressing through and experiencing the saving, sanctifying power of our Great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.
