Often the church goes through different seasons and moves of the Holy Spirit, in which the body of Christ changes as well. We at New Life believe we have an excellent team of elders and deacons to sense these moves and have to be adaptable to let the Holy Spirit work. As deacons, it is our job to serve the elders and the body of Christ so that the church

can maintain flow and organization. At New Life this tends to get a little tricky at times with the limited space and capacity that we have. We definitely want to welcome as many people as God calls to us, but will also need the cooperation of the body to accomplish this task.

New Life deacons, Rick Burnett, Marc Evers, Curtis Gordon, Mark Niemeyer, and Tom Sanford, along with the service team members, are challenged weekly with adequate seating arrangements while welcoming everyone and attempting to maintain flow and comfort. We believe with some effort and understanding from the body, this challenge will be simple.

A couple small adjustments that could help the situation are as follows:

1.) Come to church early. All the benefits of this could be a

whole other article in itself. Just one benefit of this is to be able to pick and save your preferred seat. Coming early also helps the deacons not have to scramble to find seats for those coming in after the service has begun, so that they too can engage in worship with us.

2.) Being mindful to leave

2.) Being mindful to leave space for other families. Since we are often at full capacity

in our sanctuary, it is getting harder to seat e v e r y o n e comfortably. So we ask that everyone use good judgment to maximize the number of available seats for a full congregation. The deacons are asking the congregation to

be patient and flexible when it is necessary to move people for seating adjustments.

When we experience a full congregation, chairs are added, aisle and leg space is decreased, and comfort is sacrificed by all. It is our goal to have everyone seated and ready by 10:00 AM, so that everyone can engage in the service with out interruption. How are you doing with this? We challenge everyone to put forth their best effort to make these necessary adjustments, to help yourselves and our church family to experience the joy of our spectacular Sunday services.
