

Is there a point at which we, as a believer, stop being a disciple of Jesus? No! We should continue to grow, learn, and pursue more of the knowledge of Jesus Christ. Christian Bible College and

We need to give ourselves entirely to this process! That we would remain a forever student, always pressing on to the high call of Christ in our lives. Here at New Life, we have several discipleship levels

available for you. Starting with Discipleship 1 (D1), this covers the fundamental doctrines of Christ found in Hebrews 6:1. This class will begin sometime in November. Discipleship 2 (D2) will start September 24, at 8 am. This class runs every Sunday morning except Dec. 24/31. D2 is all about you learning how to walk in the Spirit. Discipleship 3 (D3) starts on September 24, at the same time as D2. To be eligible to join the D3 class,

you must have taken D2 before coming. D3 is about learning to practice His Presence, behold His beauty, and inquire inside the temple. All of the classes are free and are offered by our church. We run a Bible College called Destiny School of Ministry as an extension of our church. This is open to all to attend. We are partnered with an accredited college, Vision

> Seminary. Coming to DSM, you can attend as an audit student, (this means you pay a minimal fee of \$25 per class), or you can attend as a forcredit student and achieve an Associate's, Bachelor's,

Master's, or Doctorate degree. Think of DSM as a fast track to discipleship. You can attend classes as you're able. All of our classes rotate every four weeks.
