WORD FROM DENNIS CRAMER

Pastor Jason

To New Life: This is a church and a school and a hospital.

When I go to churches, every church sort of stands for something. Every church sort of has its own personality. Every church has its own message. And clearly, **this church is about the healing and the restoring of the person.** People have come here from other places, and they were a mess, and the anointing, the presence, the purpose of this work, what it's here for, is to bring wholeness to the individual. Many of you came here a mess. You weren't anywhere near whole, but the presence of God, everything about this church, its culture, produces wholeness in the individual. You were made whole, you continue to be whole, and there's a lot of churches that simply don't have what you have. In a word, this church offers STABILITY. That's why you're here. It's a stable place. Things come and go, and here you are,



decades, because you were founded by a stable apostle, and now you have stable elders, and you are a stable people. So, when you came here, you signed up for stability, and you've gotten stability for years. You've been made whole by the spirit of God that's on this place. The purpose of leadership is to protect and provide. Their job is to protect you and to feed you. That's what elders do. You are a protected people and a well-fed people, and you need to understand what you really have here. There's a lot of churches that come and go. They're not stable. They have controversy in their leadership. Their doctrines are off the wall, but this church is consistent. You can be confident in it. You will be protected, and you will be fed....You are the product of a stable environment.

PERU MISSION

God's Kingdom is vast...and growing! Pastor Jason and I had the blessing of visiting and teaching our brothers and sisters in Tarapoto. It was a short trip, only 7 days in country, but it was definitely impacting! We are thankful for the church faithfully praying while we were gone.

On Tuesday, May 6, we flew out and were in Lima, Peru for a day. Then on Thursday and Friday evenings we taught



Destiny classes to the students in San Pablo Ministry School. Pastor Jason taught Spiritual Authority (in the air conditioned classroom, no hard feelings at all...), and I taught the Doctrine of Baptisms (D-1) in the open air sanctuary. We finished teaching Saturday with a 5 hour stretch! Through translators, we each had about 10 hours of teaching time and we were able to pray with them, while a couple desired and received

the Baptism of the Holy Spirit!

We visited their church events on Saturday and Sunday and we were again able to pray over people in great ministry time! Pastor Jason shared a phenomenal message on spiritual obedience in the Kingdom of God with Pastor

John Linares translating. We were blessed to honor the mothers while in Tarapoto for the "Feliz Dias de Madres" celebration

that San Pablo celebrated. There were lots of fun games and delicious food.

Another great benefit to traveling to Tarapoto, is the AMAZING regional dishes that they cook. In most restaurants you saw the fresh fruit they cut up; there was less sugar in each meal yet still delicious, and the portion sizes were incredible. There are multiple trips coming up in the next year. If you have not traveled to Peru, I highly recommend it!
